



Anti-Violence Coordinator

The Position

This position exists in the Office of the Sheriff and involves responsibility for the overseeing and coordinating the implementation of prevention-based strategies to combat gun violence within a multi-disciplinary team of public safety professionals. The duties consist primarily of internal and external communication, facilitating meetings, coordinating efforts between police, governmental agencies, and service providers, community engagement in areas where the investigation of criminal offenses occur, and reporting to the executive committee for the GIVE Task Force, who will provide direct supervision.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a Civil Service tested position and all candidates must pass a Civil Service Examination when exam is next offered.

Qualifications

Candidates must possess the following minimum qualifications to be considered:

- Bachelor's degree and twenty (20) years of law enforcement or human services experience including twenty-five (15) years in a law enforcement supervisory role and ten (10) years in criminal investigations with specific experience in gun violence related cases and evidence collection; OR
- Associate's degree and twenty-two (22) years of law enforcement or human services experience including fifteen (15) years in a law enforcement supervisory role and ten (10) years in criminal investigations with experience listed above; OR
- Graduation from high school or possession a high school equivalence diploma and twenty-four (24) years of law enforcement or human services experience including fifteen (15) years in a law enforcement supervisory role and ten (10) years in criminal investigations with experience listed above.

Salary

The annual salary for this position is \$65,000
