The Position

This position exists in the Sheriff's Department and is responsible for the daily supervision of all aspects of the Sheriff's Office, acts as the Sheriff's second in command, and serves as a confidential advisor to the Sheriff. The work involves responsibility for directing, coordinating and supervising the civil, criminal, correctional and administrative operations of the Sheriff's Office. The Undersheriff has direct involvement in overseeing the various functions of the agency and providing professional law enforcement decisions to situations as they arise. Work is performed under general supervision of the Sheriff with considerable leeway allowed for the use of independent judgment in planning the details of the work and resolving problems in emergency situations. Supervision is exercised over subordinate sworn and civilian personnel. Does related work as required

Qualifications

Candidates must possess the following minimum qualifications to be considered:

- 12 years of Law Enforcement (Police/Corrections) experience with 10 years in a high-level supervisory capacity with the rank of lieutenant or higher.
- Must have experience managing municipal budgets of \$5+ million dollars, experience with collective bargaining, labor relations, internal investigations, and must be a resident of Schenectady County.

Salary

Annual salary for the position is \$144,000.
