The Position

The Public Defender's Office is hiring for a **Senior Legal Assistant***. This position involves performing paralegal work of a complex nature with responsibility for performing a wide variety of legal duties, including but not limited to research, review, and preparation of legal documents, processing of petitions, and court orders, as well as clerical processing duties. Work is performed under general supervision in accordance with specific policies and objectives. May supervise the work of Paralegals or other clerical staff. Incumbent does related work as required.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a Civil Service tested position and all candidates must pass a Civil Service Examination when exam is next offered.

Qualifications

- A) Possession of a bachelor' degree* and two (2) years of experience in legal work; OR
- B) Possession of an *associate degree and four (4) years of experience in legal work; OR
- C) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and six (6) years of experience in legal work.
